On September 17, 1989, INSULTEC was applied to the roof of my 23 ft Shasta travel trailer. I was delighted, as the results were noticeable upon application.

The temperature outside in the sun was 108⁰F, Air-conditioner OFF, windows open and light winds. Normally under these conditions the Air Conditioner would have been mandatory but it was comfortable in the trailer.

I have a rear bathroom that doesn't cool even if the Air Conditioner is on, I requested the INSULTEC be extended half way down the rear of the trailer. Immediately after the application I entered the bathroom and found it to be very comfortable.

Since INSULTEC was applied I find I am able to refrain from turning my air conditioner on until approximately 11 am or 12 NOON. In the past I usually had to close the windows and turn on the air condition at 7.30 AM. I am able to turn the air conditioner off as the sun starts to set, as opposed to a couple of hours after it has set.

I live in my RV on a full time basis so I am constantly aware of the effect of INSULTEC. I find it a great way to cut down on the use of the Air conditioning, thus cutting down on my electric bill.

I would and will recommend the application of INSULTEC to any one interested in saving money.
